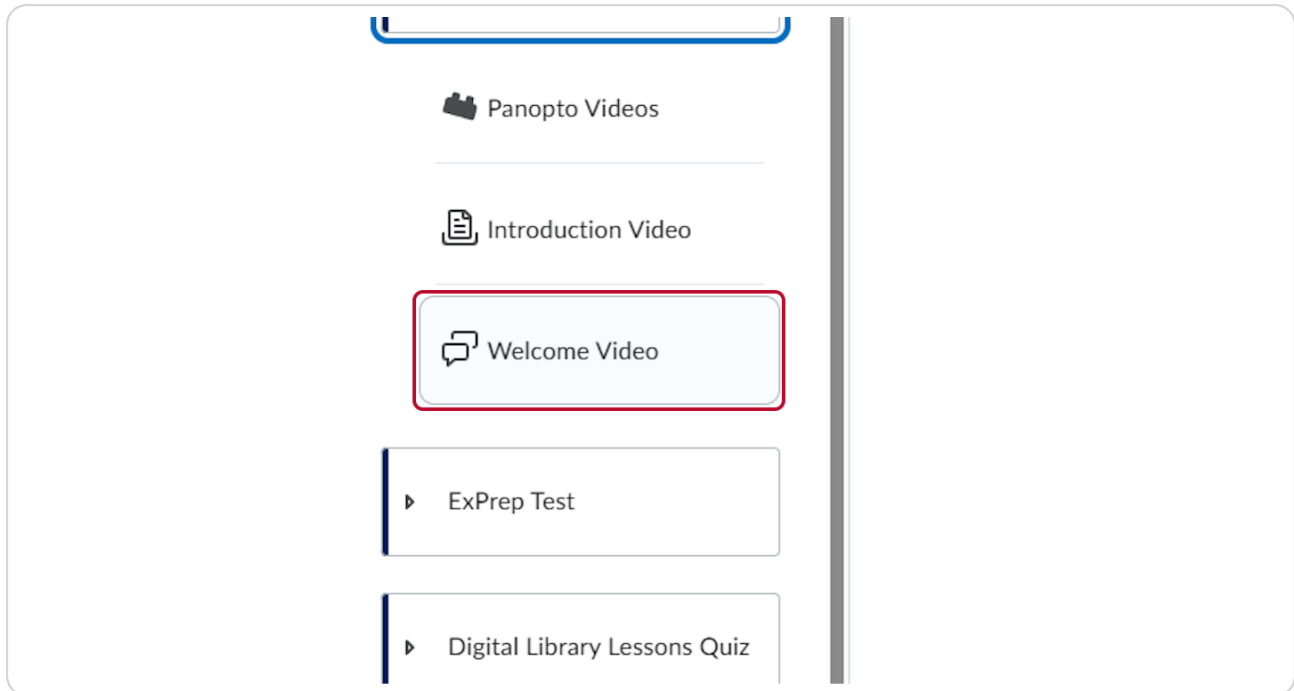

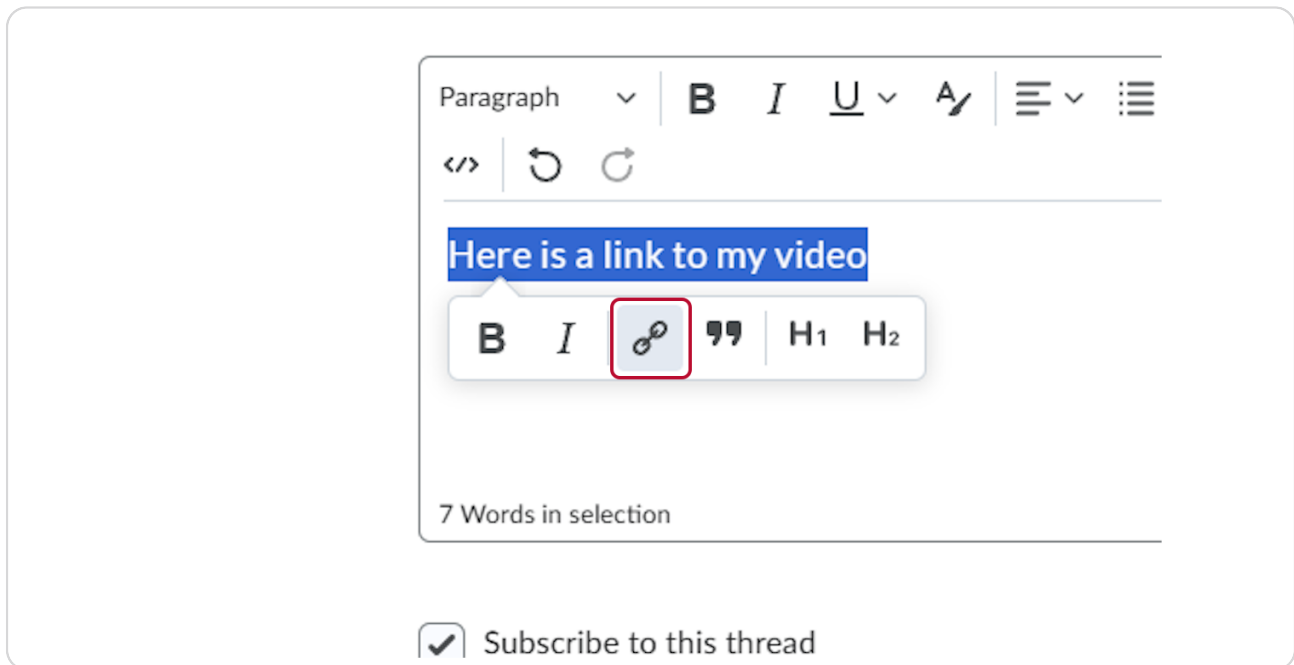

In the Comments section, add the text you want to link the video to



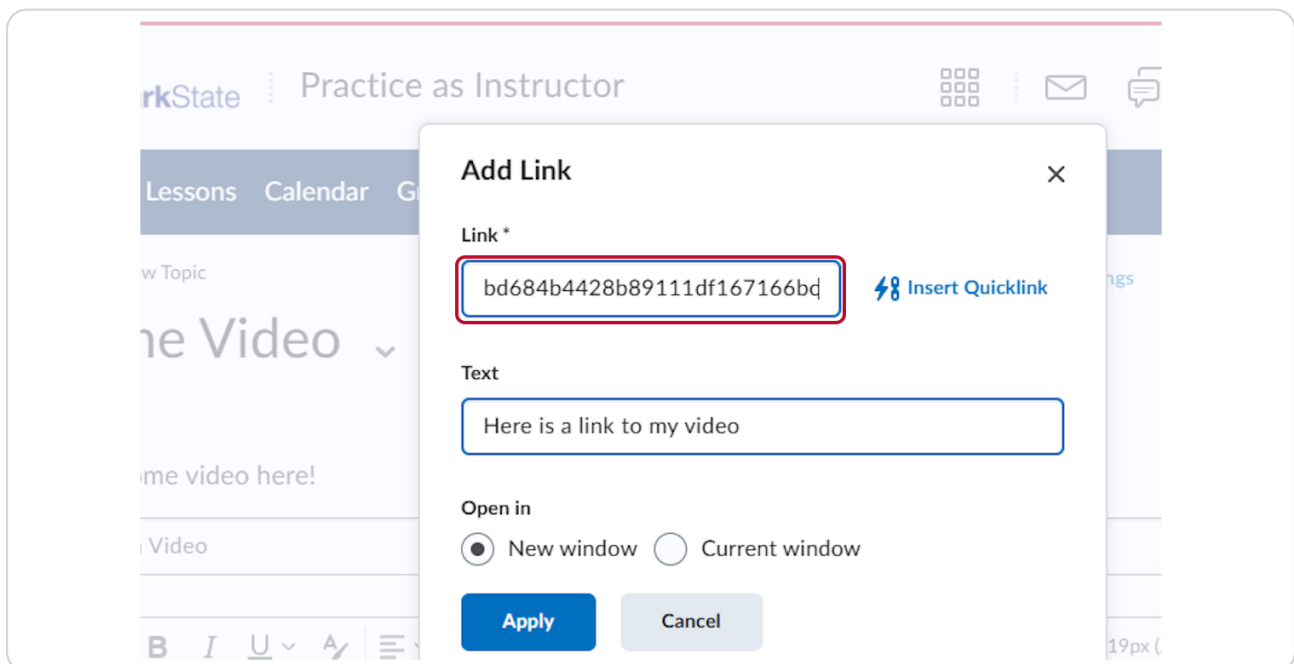
STEP 6

Highlight the text and click on Add/Edit Link




STEP 7


